Review Process

- deadline extension of 1 week for everyone (not publicly announced)
- extra deadline extension of a few days for some individuals
- rebuttal period of < 1 week after first round of reviewing (without scores)
- shepherding as last chance for savable papers (very few)
- work-in-progress as another possibility for rejected papers (very few)



Numbers

- 19 submissions 13 accepted (2 after shepherding) 6 rejected
- 60
- 60 reviews total
- 3 reviews per paper (sometimes 4 or 5)
- 12 external reviewers
- 15 external reviews

Notes:

- 1 submission was moved to DML (originally 20)
- rebuttal helps to improve the assessment
- shepherding tends to introduce a positive bias
